Vložení baterií do dálkového ovladače


Opatrně zvedněte kryt, je-li zajistěn šroubem odšroubujte jej. Vložte dvě baterie 1,5 V velikosti AAA. Ujistěte se, že (+) a (-) označení souhlasí (dbejte na správnou polaritu). Nemíchejte staré a nové baterie. Vyměňujte pouze za stejný nebo ekvivalentní typ. Nasadte kryt zpět a zajistěte jej zajistovacím šroubkem. Šroubek byl buď namontován v ovladači již z výroby a nebo je přibalen samostatně v plastovém sáčku.

Zapnutí televizoru







Průvodce úvodním nastavením, vyhledání programů televizního vysílání Spárování dálkového ovladače s televizorem

Při prvním zapnutí se před zahájením úvodního nastavení provede hledání příslušenství. Podle informací na obrazovce spárujte dálkové ovládání a další bezdrátové příslušenství s televizorem. Pro spárování dálkového ovladače, stiskněte a podržte tlačítko **Source** na přibližně 5-10 sekund a výčkejte info o spárování. Stisknutím **Exit** ukončte přidávání příslušenství a spusťte Průvodce úvodním nastavením.

Úvodní nastavení

Na uvítací obrazovce, vyberte váš jazyk a stiskněte tlačítko **OK**. Pro nastavení TV a nastavení kanálů postupujte podle pokynů na obrazovce. Průvodce instalací vás provede procesem nastavení, připojení televizoru k internetu, vyhledáním televizních kanálů v režimu příjmu televizního vysílání Live TV.

Veškerá nastavení můžete kdykoli zrušit a znovu se vrátit k nabídce Počátečního nastavení pomocí možnosti **Obnovit** v nabídce **Nastavení > Předvolby zařízení**. Do nabídky **Nastavení** se dostanete z **Domovské obrazovky**, kterou vyvoláte stisknutím tlačítka Home na ovladači a nebo pokud jste v režimu Live TV tak z nabídky **Možnosti TV**, kterou vyvoláte stisknutím tlačítka Menu.

Vyhledání programů televizního vysílání

Po nastavení připojení k internetu a konfiguraci vašeho účtu vám průvodce instalací nabídne možnost vyhledání programů televizního vysílání. Nejprve zvolíte typ tuneru.

Satelit

Pokud vyberete možnost **Satelit**, televizor vyhledá programy digitálního satelitního vysílání. Vyberte typ Satelitu – Preferovaný nebo Obecný. Chcete-li instalaci **Skylink (M7)** volte **Preferovaný** a v další volbě **Skylink**.

Vyhledávání LNB – po volbě **Vyhledat** televizor zjistí možnosti připojené satelitní antény tj. jaké jsou v anténě připojené LNB a jaké satelitní družice přijímají. Výsledek vyhledávání se zobrazí v tabulce.

Pro instalaci **Skylink doporučujeme tuto možnost spíše přeskočit** tím pádem se zobrazí základní povární nastavení LNB takto : Družice ASTRA 1 (19,2°) = DiSEqC A , ASTRA 3 (23,5°) = DiSEqC B.

Na každé družici zkонтrolujte, kvalitu a úroveň signálu, na názvu družice stiskněte tlačítko OK a ve výpisu vlastností jedte šípkou dolů až na řádky Kvalita signálu a Úroveň signálu.

Zpět se vrátíte stisknutím tlačítka Back. Zkontrolujte obě družice.

Pokud na jedné nebo obou družicích není dostatečná úroveň a kvalita signálu, zjistěte u správce či instalační firmy správnou konfiguraci LNB a DiSEqC zapojení a tyto hodnoty pak nastavte v tabulce parametrů družic, dokud nemáte úroveň a kvalitu v pořádku nemá smysl pokračovat dále ve vyhledávání.

Je-li signál na obou družicích v pořádku stiskněte tlačítko **ŠÍPKA VPRAVO** a na obrazovce Automatické vyhledávání kanálů zvolte **Vyhledat** a v další volbě opět tlačítkem **ŠÍPKA VPRAVO** spusťte vyhledávání. Průběh vyhledávání a informace o dokončení se zobrazují na obrazovce.

Anténa

Pokud vyberete možnost **Anténa**, televizor vyhledá pozemní digitální (DVB T-2) a analogové vysílání. Na další obrazovce zvýrazněte možnost **Scan** (Skenovat) a stisknutím tlačítka **OK** spusťte vyhledávání nebo vybráním možnosti **Skip Scan** (Přeskočit skenování) pokračujte bez provedení vyhledávání.

Kabel

Pokud je vybrána možnost **Kabelová TV**, televizor vyhledá digitální kabelové a analogové vysílání. Po nastavení všech parametrů vyberte **Scan** (Skenovat) a stisknutím tlačítka **OK** spusťte vyhledávání nebo vybráním možnosti **Skip Scan** (Přeskočit skenování) pokračujte bez provedení vyhledávání.

Seznamy kanálů, přepínání mezi režimy satelitní, pozemní a kabelové tv

Televizor řadí uložené stanice tv a rozhlasového vysílání v **seznamu kanálů**. Seznamy jsou pro každý Režim instalace samostatné. Stisknutím tlačítka OK v režimu Live TV otevřete Seznam kanálů. Kanály, které jsou uvedeny v seznamu, můžete procházet pomocí **Směrových tlačítek** (nahoru / dolů) dálkového ovladače, chcete-li na zvýrazněný kanál přepnout stiskněte tlačítko **OK**.

Stisknutím **červeného / zeleného** tlačítka můžete krokovat v seznamu po stránkách nahoru / dolů. Stisknutím **žlutého** tlačítka zobrazíte další možnosti jako jsou Vybrat typ, Seřadit a Najít. Chcete-li filtrovat kanály, zvýrazněte možnost Vybrat typ a stiskněte tlačítko **OK**. Pro filtrování seznamu je několik možností, volba **Vysílání** zobrazí všechny nainstalované kanály v rámci aktuálního režimu.

Ceština 3

Úpravy seznamu kanálů můžete provést po volbě **Nastavení > Kanál > Kanály**, kde jsou k dispozici aktualizace kanálů a také možnosti Přeskočení, Řazení, Posunutí, Úprava kanálu a Vymazání seznamu.

Možnosti úprav mohou být omezené v závislosti na počátečním nastavení, volbě operátora u satelitu a v závislosti na aktivaci LCN. Nastavení **LCN** můžete vypnout v nabídce Nastavení > Kanál, protože brání úpravám kanálů. Tato možnost může být ve výchozím nastavení nastavena na **On** (Zapnuto), v závislosti na zemi vybrané během počátečního nastavení.

Přepínání mezi režimy satelitní, pozemní a nebo kabelové televize.

Sledování satelitního, pozemního nebo kabelového vysílání (režim LIVE TV)

Stisknutím tlačítka **Home**  zobrazíte **Domovskou obrazovku** s nabídkou aplikací a služeb. Pro sledování programů satelitního, pozemního nebo kabelového vysílání **najedte na okno aplikace Live TV a stiskněte OK**. Do režimu Live TV se můžete přepnout také výběrem možnosti **Kanály** v nabídce **Vstupy** na horní liště Domovské obrazovky nebo stisknutím tlačítka **EPG** nebo **Source**.

Mezi programy můžete přepínat pomocí tlačítek **Program +/-** nebo pomocí **Směrových tlačítek** (šipka nahoru/dolů) a nebo přímou volbou **Numerickými tlačítky** na dálkovém ovladači.

Programový průvodce

Prostřednictvím EPG (Elektronický programový průvodce) můžete procházet plán událostí nainstalovaných kanálů. Závisí na vysílání, zda je funkce podporována nebo ne. Chcete-li na Domovské obrazovce a nebo v režimu Live TV spustit EPG, stiskněte na dálkovém ovladači tlačítko **EPG**.

Přehrávač multimédií

Na **Domovské obrazovce** přejděte do řádku Aplikace, vyberte položku **Multi Media Player (MMP)** a spusťte stisknutím tlačítka **OK**.

Na hlavní obrazovce přehrávače médií vyberte typ média. **Modrým** tlačítkem můžete přepínat mezi typy zobrazení jako **Zobrazení seznamu** a **Mřížkové zobrazení**. Pokud je nastaveno Zobrazení seznamu, tak při procházení videí se v okně na levé straně obrazovky zobrazí náhled zvýrazněného videa.

Z připojeného USB

Na mobilním zařízení otevřete soubor, který chcete sdílet, a klepněte na ikonu sdílení nebo na související možnost z nabídky mobilního zařízení. Zobrazí se dostupná zařízení. Ze seznamu vyberte TV. Název zařízení televizoru je uveden v nabídce **Nastavení > Nastavení zařízení > O aplikaci**. Pokud je připojení úspěšně navázáno, vybraný soubor média se přehraje / zobrazí na vašem televizoru.

Nahrávání na USB

Pro nahrávání programu připojte USB disk zatímco je TV vypnutá. Chcete-li nahrávat HD programy, jako jsou filmy, doporučuje se používat USB pevné disky (HDD). Pokud si přejete, můžete nahrávky ukládat/kopírovat do počítače. Soubory však nebude možno na počítači přehrávat. Nahrávky lze přehrávat pouze pomocí vaší TV. Nahrávání z rádia není podporováno. Nemí-li rychlosť připojeného USB zařízení dostatečná, nahrávání se nemusí podařit a funkce časového posunu nemusí být dostupná. Během nahrávání nevytahujte USB/HDD, může to poškodit připojený disk. Některé streamové bloky se nemusí nahrát kvůli problémům se signálem, z tohoto důvodu může video někdy během přehrávání zmrznout.

Okamžité nahrávání

Pro okamžité nahrávání sledovaného programu stiskněte tlačítka **Nahrávání**. Pro zrušení okamžitého stiskněte tlačítka **Stop**. Během režimu nahrávání nelze přepnout na jiný kanál.

Nahrávání z časovače

Pomocí nabídky **Seznam plánů** můžete přidat připomenutí nebo nahrát časovače. **Seznam plánů** je přístupný z nabídky **Nahrát** v režimu Live TV. Zvýrazněte možnost **Seznam plánů** a stiskněte **OK**. Zobrazí se dříve nastavené časovače, pokud jsou k dispozici. Když je na obrazovce zobrazena nabídka **Seznam plánů**, stisknutím tlačítka **Nahrávání** přidáte další událost.

Událost do Seznamu plánů **můžete také přidat přímým zadáním z EPG**. Využijte EPG, najedete na událost, kterou chcete nahrávat a stiskněte tlačítka **Nahrávání**, zobrazí se tabulka zadání události do Seznamu plánů pro potvrzení či úpravu parametrů události.

Sledování náhrávek

Vyberte nabídku **Seznam náhrávek** z nabídky **Nahrát** v režimu Live TV a stiskněte tlačítka **OK**. Ze seznamu vyberte nahranou položku (byla-li dříve nahrána). Stisknutím tlačítka **OK** spusťte sledování. Stisknutím tlačítka **Stop** nebo (Zpět / Návrat) zastavte přehrávání.





Assembling / Removing the pedestal Preparations

Take out the pedestal(s) and the TV from the packing case and put the TV onto a work table with the screen panel down on a clean and soft cloth (blanket, etc.).

- Use a flat and firm table bigger than the TV.
- Do not hold the screen panel part.
- Make sure not to scratch or break the TV.

Assembling the pedestal

1. Place the pedestal(s) on the mounting pattern(s) on the rear side of the TV.
2. Insert the screws provided and tighten them gently until the pedestal(s) are properly fitted.


Removing the pedestal from the TV

Other Connections

Antenna Connection

Connect the aerial or cable TV plug to the AERIAL INPUT (ANT) socket located on the left side of the TV or satellite plug to the SATELLITE INPUT (LNB) socket located on the rear side of the TV.



When using the wall mounting kit
(contact your dealer to purchase one, if not supplied), we recommend that you plug all your cables into their back of the TV before mounting on the wall. Insert or remove the CM module only when the TV is SWITCHED OFF. You should refer to the module instruction manual for details of the settings. The USB inputs on the TV support devices up to 500mA. Connecting devices that have current value above 500mA may damage your TV. When connecting equipment using a HDMI cable to your TV, to guarantee sufficient immunity against parasitic frequency radiation and noise-free transmission of high definition signals, such as 4K content, you have to use a high speed shielded (high grade) HDMI cable with ferrites.

TV Control & Operation

Remote Control



The control button allows you to control the Quick Standby-on function of the TV.
Note: The position of the control button may differ depending on the model.

T turn off the TV if (Quick Standby): Press the control button to turn the TV into quick standby mode.
T turn the TV if (Standby): The TV cannot be switched into standby mode via control button.
To turn on the TV: Press the control button, the TV will turn on.
Note: Live TV settings menu OSD in Live TV mode cannot be displayed via the control button.

Input Selection

Press the **Menu** button on your remote control to display Live TV settings menu when in Live TV mode. Press **Home** button to display or return to the Home Screen of the Android TV. Use the directional buttons to move the focus, proceed, adjust some settings and press **OK** to make selections in order to make changes, set your preferences, enter a sub-menu, launch an application, etc. Press **Back/Return** to return to the previous menu screen.


Input Selection

Once you have connected external systems to your TV, you can switch to different input sources. Press the **Source** button on your remote control consecutively or use the directional buttons and then press the **OK** button to switch to different sources when in Live TV mode. Or enter the **Inputs** menu on the Home Screen, select the desired source from the list and press **OK**.

Changing Channels and Volume

You can adjust the volume by using the **Volume +/-** buttons and change the channel in Live TV mode by using the **Programme +/-** buttons on the remote.

Inserting the Batteries into the Remote

The remote may have a screw that secures the battery compartment cover on the remote control (or this may be in a separate bag). Remove the screw if the cover is screwed on previously, then remove the battery compartment cover to reveal the battery compartment. Insert two 1.5V size **AAA** batteries. Make sure the (+) and (-) signs match (observe correct polarity). Do not mix old and new batteries. Replace only with same or equivalent type. Place the cover back on. Secure the cover again with the screw, if any.

To pair remote with the TV

When the TV is turned on for the first time, a search for accessories will be performed after the initial setup starts. You will need to pair your remote control with your TV at this point. Press and hold the **Source** button on the remote until the LED on the remote starts to blink, then release the **Source** button. That means the remote is in pairing mode.

Now you will wait for the TV to find your remote. Select the name of your remote and press **OK** when it appears on the TV screen.

When the pairing process is successful, the LED on the remote will go off. If the pairing process fails the remote will enter sleep mode after 30 seconds.

In order to pair remote later on, you can do to **Settings** menu, **highlight Remotes & Accessories option** and press **OK** to start a search for accessories.

Turning On/Off the TV

Connect power

IMPORTANT: The TV set is designed to operate on 220-240V AC, 50 Hz socket. After unpacking, allow the TV set to reach the ambient room temperature before you connect the set to the mains.

Plug the power cord to the mains socket outlet. The TV will switch on automatically.

To switch the TV from standby

If the TV is in standby mode the standby LED lights up. To switch the TV from standby mode either:

- Press the **Standby** button on the remote control.
- Press the control button on the TV.

The TV will then switch on.

To switch the TV into standby

The TV cannot be switched into standby mode via control button. Press and hold the **Standby** button on the remote control. **P** or **ff** dialogue will appear on the screen. Highlight **OK** and press the **OK** button. The TV will switch into standby mode.

T switch ff the TV

To power down the TV completely, unplug the power cord from the mains socket.

Quick Standby Mode

In order to switch the TV into quick standby mode either:

• Press the **Standby** button on the remote.

Press again to go back to operating mode.

• Press the control button on the TV.

Press the control button again to go back to operating mode.

Your TV continues to operate in the quick standby mode state, as it regularly checks for updates. This is not a malfunction, it meets the requirements for energy consumption. In order to minimise energy consumption switch your TV into standby mode as explained above.

Programme Guide

By means of Electronic Programme Guide (EPG) function of your TV, you can browse the event schedule of the currently installed channels on your channel list. It depends on the related broadcast whether this feature is supported or not.

Electronic Programme Guide is available in Live TV mode. To switch to Live TV mode you can either press the **Ext** button or highlight the **Live TV** app from the **Apps** row on the Home Screen and press **OK**. For some countries, the **Live TV** app will be situated in the **Home** tab on the Home Screen and the row with this app will be named as **Favorite Apps**. In order

Restart: A confirmation message will be displayed, select **Restart** to proceed with restarting. The TV will switch off/on first. Select **Cancel** to exit.

Remote & Accessories

You can use wireless accessories, such as remote control (depends on the model of the remote control), headphones, keyboards or game controllers with your Android TV. Add devices to use them with your TV. Select this option and press **OK** to start searching available devices to pair them with your TV. If available highlight **Add accessory** option and press **OK** to start the search. Set your device to pairing mode. Available devices will be recognised and listed or pairing request will be displayed. To start pairing, select your device from the list and press **OK**, or highlight **OK** and press **OK** when the pairing request appears. A device highlighted will also be listed here. To unpair a device, highlight **OK** and press **OK**. Then highlight the **Unpair** option and press **OK**. Then select **OK** and press **OK** again to unpair the device from the TV. You can also change the name of a connected device. Highlight the device and press **OK**, then highlight **Change name** and press **OK** again. Press **OK** again and use the virtual keyboard to change the name of the device.

Channel List

The TV controls stored channels in the **Channel List**. Press the **OK** button to open the **Channel List** in Live TV mode. You can press the left directional button to scroll up the list page by page, or press the right directional button to scroll down.

To sort the channel or find a channel in the channel list, press the **Yellow** button to display the **Channel Operation** options. Available options are **Sort** and **Find**. **Sort** option may not be available depending on the selected country during the initial setup process. To sort the channels highlight **Sort** and press the **OK** button. Select one of the available options and press **OK** again. The channels will be sorted according to your selection. To find a channel highlight **Find** and press the **OK** button. Virtual keyboard will be displayed. Enter all or a portion of the name or number of the channel you want to find, highlight the check mark symbol on the keyboard and press **OK**. Matching results will be listed.

To filter the channels press **Red** button. **Select TV** options will be displayed. You can select among **TV Radio Free**, **Encrypted** and **Favourites** options to filter the channel list or select **All channels** option to see all installed channels in the channel list. Available options will differ depending on the operator selection.

Note: If any option selected, **All channels** is selected in the **Select Type** menu, you can only scroll through the channels that are currently listed in the channel list using **Programme +/-** buttons on the remote.

In the formatting, you may consider backing up the data on your USB device to your TV's internal storage or another local USB storage device using the **Back up apps** option. Otherwise, some apps may not work properly after formatting. Follow the on-screen instructions and read the information displayed on the screen before proceeding.

Note: Formating the connected storage device will erase all data installed on it. Back up the files that you want to keep before you proceed with formatting the device.

You can also go to the **N** **title** in section on the Home Screen after connecting your USB device to your TV to see the available options. Highlight the notification related to your connected USB device and press **OK**.

Browse: Opens the **Storage** menu.

Setup as device storage: Has the same functionality as the **Erase & Format as device storage** option described above.

Eject: Same as described above.

Home Screen: Customise your Home Screen. Select channels which will be displayed on the Home Screen, enable/disable video and audio previews, Organise apps and games, change their order or get more of them. Display open source licences.

For some countries, the Home Screen will be organised into several tabs and this menu will contain additional options to customise the content of these tabs. Highlight **Set up** and press **OK** to sign in to a Google account, so you can browse personalised recommendations for that account in the Home Screen. After signing in, using the related options in this menu, you can view your account activity controls and permissions, customise services and define content preferences to get better recommendations.

Store Mode: Highlight **Store mode** and press **OK**. A dialogue will be displayed for you to confirmation. Read the description, highlight **Continue** and press **OK** if you want to proceed. Then highlight **On** to activate **Off** to deactivate and press **OK**. In store mode your TV's settings will be configured for store environment and the supported features will be displayed on the screen. Once activated, **Store Messaging** and **RQ Demo** settings will become available. Set according to your preferences. It is recommended not to activate store mode for home use.

Google Assistant: Highlight **On** and press **OK** to turn this feature on, or off. Select your active account, view permissions, select which apps to include in search results, activate safe search filter and offensive word blocking, view open source licences.

Chromecast Built-in: Set your remote control notification preference. Highlight **Let others control your cast media** and press **OK**. Always, While casting

To access the Electronic Programme Guide press the **Guide** button on the remote.

Use the directional buttons to navigate through the programme guide. You can use the Up/Down directional buttons or **Programme +/-** buttons to switch to previous/next channel on the list and Right/Left directional buttons to select a desired event of the currently highlighted channel. If available, the full name, start-and-end date, genre of the highlighted event and a brief information about it will be displayed on the Screen button.

Press **Blue** button to filter the events. Due to the large variety of filter options you can find events of the desired type quicker. Press **Yellow** button to see detailed information on the highlighted event. You can also use the **Red** and **Green** buttons to see events of previous day and next day. The functions will be assigned to the colour buttons on the remote when they are available. Follow the on-screen information for accurate button functions.

Press the **Record** button to add a timer for the highlighted event in the guide. You can define the type of the timer by setting the **Schedule Type** option as **Reminder** or **Record**. When other parameters are set the **Green** button. The timer will be added to the schedule list. You can access the schedule list from the **Record** menu in Live TV mode.

The guide can not be displayed if DTV input source is blocked from the **Settings**→**Channel**→**Parental Controls**→**Inputs Blocked** menu in Live TV mode or on Home Screen.

Connecting to the Internet

You can access the Internet via your TV, by connecting it to a broadband system in order to enjoy a variety of streaming content, and internet applications. These settings can be configured from **Settings**→**Network & Internet** menu. You can also highlight the **Connected/Not Connected** icon on the Home screen and **OK** to access this menu. For further information refer to **Network & Internet** section under the title of **Settings**.


Wired Connection

Connect your TV to your modem/router via an Ethernet cable. There is a LAN port on the rear side of your TV. The status of the connection under the **Ethernet** section in the **Network & Internet** menu will change from **Not connected** to **Connected**.

You might be able to connect your TV to a network wall socket depending on your network's configuration. In that case, you can connect your TV directly to the network using an Ethernet cable.

Wireless Connection

A wireless LAN modem/router is required to connect the TV to the Internet via wireless LAN. Highlight **Wi-Fi** option in the **Network & Internet** menu and **press OK** to enable wireless connection. Available networks will be listed. Select one and **press OK** to connect. For more information refer to **Network & Internet** section under the title of **Settings**.

Wired Connection

Connect your TV to your modem/router via an Ethernet cable. There is a LAN port on the rear side of your TV.

The status of the connection under the **Ethernet** section in the **Network & Internet** menu will change from **Not connected** to **Connected**.

Wireless Connection

On the Home Screen scroll to **Apps** row, select **Multi Media Player (MMP)** and press the **OK** button to launch. If this app is not available, highlight **Add app to favourites** (or sign on) on the **Apps** row and press **OK**. Then select the **Multi Media Player (MMP)** app and press **OK** to open. Select the media type on the main media player screen.

On the next screen, you can press the **Menu** button to access a list of menu options while the focus is on a folder or a media file. You will also be able to copy, paste and delete the media files using the selected options of this menu.

If a PVR32 formatted USB storage device is connected to the TV. Additionally you can switch the viewing style by selecting either **Normal Parser** or **Recursive Parser**. In **Normal Parser** mode the files will be displayed with folders if any available. So only the selected type of media files in the root folder or in the selected folder will be displayed. If there isn't any media files of the selected type, the folder will be assumed as empty. In **Recursive Parser** mode the source will be searched for all available media files of the selected type and the found files will be listed. Press the **Back/Return** button to close this menu.

In order to activate photo frame feature select **Photo** as the media type. Then press the **Menu** button, highlight **Photo Frame** and press **OK**. If you select **One Photo mode** option and press **OK** the image that you set as photo frame earlier will be displayed when photo frame feature is activated. If you select the **USB storage device** option the first file in **Recursive Parser** mode will be displayed. To set the photo frame image press the **Menu** button while the photo file of the service is displayed, highlight **Photo Frame** and press **OK**.

Additionally, you can toggle between browsing modes by pressing the **Blue** button. List View and Grid View modes are available. While browsing for the video, photo and text files a preview of the highlighted file will be displayed in a small window on the left side of the screen if the browse mode is set to List View. You

You must change your modem's SSID when there are any other modems around with the same SSID. You can encounter connection problems otherwise. Use a wired connection if you experience problems with a wireless connection.

A stable connection speed is required to play back streaming content. Use an Ethernet connection if the wireless LAN speed is unstable.

Multi Media Player

On the Home Screen scroll to **Apps** row, select **Multi Media Player (MMP)** and press the **OK** button to launch. If this app is not available, highlight **Add app to favourites** (or sign on) on the **Apps** row and press **OK**. Then select the **Multi Media Player (MMP)** app and press **OK** to open. For some countries, the **Multi Media Player** app will be situated in the **Home** tab on the Home Screen and the row with this app will be named as **Favourites Apps**.

Select the media type on the main media player screen. On the next screen, you can press the **Menu** button to access a list of menu options while the focus is on a folder or a media file. Using the options of this menu you can change the media type, sort the files, change the thumbnail size and turn your TV into a digital photo frame. You will also be able to copy, paste and delete the media files using the selected options of this menu. If a PVR32 formatted USB storage device is connected to the TV. While browsing for the video, photo and text files a preview of the highlighted file will be displayed in a small window on the left side of the screen if the browse mode is set to List View. You

can also use **Programme +**- buttons to jump directly to the first and last folder or file if the view style is set to Grid View.

You can also enable or disable the USB Auto Play feature by pressing the **Yellow** button. Using this feature you can set your TV to start playing the media content installed on a connected USB storage device automatically. Refer to the **USB Auto Play Feature** section for more information.

Video/Files
Press **OK** to play back the highlighted video file.
Info: Display the info bar. Press twice to display the extended information and the next file.

Pause/Play: Pause and resume the playback.
Rewind: Start reverse playback. Press consecutively to set to the rewind speed.

Fast Forward: Start fast forward playback. Press consecutively to set to the forward playback speed.

Stop: Stop the playback.

Programme +: Switch to next file.

Programme -: Switch to previous file.

Back/Return: Return to the media player screen.

Music/Files

Press **OK** to play back the highlighted music/audio file.
Info: Display the extended information and the next file.

Pause/Play: Pause and resume the playback.

Rewind: Press and hold to rewind.

Fast Forward: Press and hold to fast forward.

Stop: Stop the playback.

Programme +: Switch to next file.

Programme -: Switch to previous file.

Back/Return: Return to the media player screen.

If you press **Back/Return** button without stopping the playback first the playback will continue while you are browsing in the multimedia player. You can use the media player buttons to control the playback or switch the media type to **Video**.

Photo/Files

Press **OK** to display the highlighted photo file. When you press the **OK** button slide show will start and all photo files in the current folder or in the storage device, depending on the viewing style, will be displayed in order. Pause/Play: Pause and resume the slide show.

Green button (Rotate/Duration): Rotate the image / Set the interval between the slide shows.

Yellow (12 m/Eff): Zoom in on the image / Apply various effects to the slide show.

Programme +: Switch to next file.

Programme -: Switch to previous file.

Back/Return: Return to the media player screen.

Text/Files

When you press the **OK** button slide show will start and all text files in the current folder or in the storage device, depending on the viewing style, will be displayed in order. If the **Repeat** option is set to **None** only the files between the highlighted one and the last listed one will be displayed. Press the **OK** or **Pause/Play** button to pause or resume the slide show. The slide show will stop after the last listed file is displayed and media player screen will be displayed.

Info: Display the info bar. Press twice to display the extended information and the next file.

Pause/Play: Pause and resume the slide show.

Programme +: Switch to next file.

Programme -: Switch to previous file.

Back/Return: Return to the media player screen.

Music/Files

Press **OK** to play back the highlighted music/audio file.
Info: Display the extended information and the next file.

Pause/Play: Pause and resume the playback.

Rewind: Press and hold to rewind.

Fast Forward: Press and hold to fast forward.

Stop: Stop the playback.

Programme +: Switch to next file.

Programme -: Switch to previous file.

Back/Return: Return to the media player screen.

If you press **Back/Return** button without stopping the playback first the playback will continue while you are browsing in the multimedia player. You can use the media player buttons to control the playback or switch the media type to **Video**.

Photo/Files

Press **OK** to display the highlighted photo file. When you press the **OK** button slide show will start and all photo files in the current folder or in the storage device, depending on the viewing style, will be displayed in order. Press the **OK** or **Pause/Play** button to pause or resume the slide show. The image will be shown to stop after the last listed file is displayed and media player screen will be displayed.

You can view your photos, text documents or play your music and video files installed on a connected USB storage device on the TV. Plug in the USB storage device to one of the USB inputs on the TV.

On the main media player screen select the desired media type. On the next screen, highlight a file name from the list of available media files and press the **OK** button. Follow the on-screen instructions for more information on other available button functions.

Note: Wait a little while before each plugging and unplugging as the player may still be reading files. Failure to do so may cause physical damage to the USB player and the USB device itself. Do not pull out your drive while playing a file.

USB Auto Play Feature

This feature is used to start playing the media content installed on a removable device automatically. It uses the Multi Media Player application. The media content types have different storage device while activating the reading priority order is as Photo, Video and Audio. That means, if there is Photo content in content in the root directory of the removable device, the Multi Media Player will play the Photo in a sequence (in file name order) instead of Video or Audio files. If not, it will be checked for Video content and as last Audio.

Font: Set to the font options. Size, style and colour can be set according to your preferences.

Show Info: Display the extended information.

Photo Frame Image: Set the currently displayed image as photo frame image. This image will be displayed in the **One Photo mode** selected instead of the connected storage device while activating the photo frame feature. Otherwise all files will be played back as a slide show when photo frame feature is activated.

Screen Show Spectrum: Hide or show the spectrum if available.

Lyric Options: Display lyric options if available.

Picture Off: Open the power menu of your TV. You can use the **Picture** off function here to turn the screen off. Press a button on the remote or on the TV to turn the screen on again.

Screen Mode: Set the aspect ratio option.

Picture Settings: Display the picture settings menu.

Sound Settings: Display the sound settings menu.

Sound Track: Set the soundtrack option if more than one available.

Last Memory: Set to **Time** if you want to resume the playback from the position where it was stopped next time you open the same video file. If set to **Off** the playback will start from the beginning. Highlight an option and press **OK** to change the setting.

Seek: Jump to a specific line of the video file. Use the numeric and directional buttons to enter the time and press **OK**.

Subtitle Encoding: Display subtitle encoding options if available.

This feature will only work if all of the following circumstances occur:

- The USB Auto Play feature is enabled
- The USB device is plugged in
- Playable content is installed on the USB device

To record a programme, you should first connect a USB storage device to your TV. While the TV is switched off, you should then switch on the TV to enable the recording feature.

To recording duration programmes such as movies, it is recommended to use SSB Hard disk drives (HDD's). Recorded programmes are saved onto the connected SSB storage device. If desired, you can store copy recordings onto a computer; however, these files will not be available to be played on a computer. You will play the recordings only via your TV.

USB Recording

From USB Connection

IMPORTANT: Back up the files on your storage devices before connecting them to the TV. Manufacturer will not be responsible for any file damage or data loss. Certain types of memory sticks may not be compatible with this TV. The TV supports FAT32 format partitioning. NTFS and unsupported FAT32 formatted devices with a storage capacity larger than 2TB are not supported. Files larger than 4 GB are not supported.

If the writing speed of the connected USB storage device is not sufficient, the recording may fail and the timeshifting feature may not be available. It is recommended to use USB hard disk drives for recording HD programmes.

Do not pull out the USB/HDD during a recording. This may harm the connected USB/HDD. Some stream packets may not be recorded because of signal problems, as a result sometimes videos may freeze during play-back.

If a recording starts from timer when telext is on, a dialogue will be displayed. If you highlight **Yes** and press **OK** telext will be turned off and recording will start. You can not switch broadcasts during the recording mode.

Instant Recording

Press **Record** button to start recording an event instantly while watching a programme. Press **Stop** button to stop and save the instant recording.

Press **Record** button to start recording a programme from the list (if previously recorded). Press the **OK** button to watch.

Press the **Stop** or **Back**/**Return** button to stop a play-back.

The recordings will be named in the following format: **Channel Name_Date(Year/Month/Day)_Programme Name.**

Timeshift Recording

In order to use timeshift recording feature **Time Shift Mode** option in the **Record>Time Shift Mode** menu should be enabled first.

In timeshifted mode, the programme is paused and simultaneously recorded to the connected USB storage device. Press **Pause/Play** button while watching a broadcast to activate timeshifting mode. Press **Pause/Play** button again to resume the paused programme from where you stopped. Press the **Stop** button to stop timeshift recording and return to the live broadcast. When this feature is used for the first time **Disk Setup** wizard will be displayed when the **Pause/Play** button is pressed. You can either choose **Auto** or **Manual** setup mode. In **Manual** mode, if you prefer, you can format your USB storage device and specify the storage location that will be used for timeshift function. When the setup is complete, the **Disk Setup Result** will be displayed. Press **OK** button to exit.

Timeshift function will not be available for radio broadcasts.

ttings>Device Preferences>Inputs menu in Live TV mode.

- Scroll down to **Consumer Electronic Control (CEC)** section. Check if the **HDMI control option** is switched on.
- Highlight the **HDMI** control option and press **OK** switch on or off.

Make sure that all CEC settings are properly set up on the connected CEC device. The CEC functionality has different names on different brands. CEC function might not work with all devices. If you connect a device without CEC support to your TV, the related HDMI input source will be renamed with the connected device's name.

To operate the connected CEC device, select the related HDMI input source from the **Inputs** menu on the **Home Screen**. Open press the **Source** button on the TV in Live TV mode and select the related HDMI input source from the list. To terminate this operation and control the TV via the remote again, press the **Source** button, which will still be functional, on the remote and switch to another source.

The TV remote is automatically able to control the device once the connected HDMI source has been selected. However, not all buttons will be forwarded to the device. Only devices that support CEC Remote Control function respond to the TV remote control. The TV supports also eARC (Enhanced Audio Return Channel) feature. Similar to the ARC, the eARC feature enables the transfer of the digital audio stream from the TV to connected audio device via the HDMI cable. eARC is an improved version of ARC. It has a much higher bandwidth than its predecessor. Bandwidth represents the range of frequencies or amount of data that is being transferred at a time. Higher bandwidth translates into a higher amount of data that can be transferred. Higher bandwidth also means that digital audio signal doesn't have to be compressed and is much more detailed, rich, and vibrant.

Press **Exit** button to close the Schedule List.

CEC

With CEC function of your TV you can operate a connected device with the TV remote control. This function uses HDMI CEC (Consumer Electronics Control) to communicate with the connected devices. Devices must support HDMI CEC and must be connected with an HDMI connection.

In order to make use of the CEC functionality the related option in the menu should be switched on.

To check, switch on or off the CEC function, do the following:

- Scroll down to **Consumer Electronic Control (CEC)** section. Check if the **HDMI control option** is switched on.
- Highlight the **HDMI** control option and press **OK**.

Some HDMI cables do not have enough bandwidth to carry high-bit-rate audio channels, so an HDMI cable with eARC support (HDMI High Speed Cable with Ethernet and the new Ultra High Speed HDMI Cable - check [hdmiong.com](#) for latest info).

Note: eARC is supported only via the HDMI2 input.

Google Cast

With the built-in Google Cast technology, you can cast the content from your mobile device straight to your TV. If your mobile device has Google Cast feature, you can mirror your device screen to your TV wirelessly. Select **Cast** screen option on your android device. Available devices will be detected and listed. Select your TV from the list, and tap on it to start casting.

Select the **TV screen** from the **TV screen...** menu on the **Settings>Device Preferences>About** menu from the **Home Screen**. Device name will be one of the shown options. You can also change the name of your TV.

HighLight Device name and press OK. Then highlight **Change and press OK** again. You can either select one of the predefined names or enter a custom name. To cast your device's screen to the **TV screen...**

1. On your android device, go to **Settings** from the notification panel or home screen

2. Tap on **Device Connectivity'**

3. "Tap on the 'Easy projection' and enable 'Wireless projection'. Available devices will be listed

4. Press the TV you would like to cast to

or

1. Slide down the notification panel

2. "Tap on **Wireless projection'**

3. Select the TV you would like to cast to

If the mobile app is Cast-enabled, such as YouTube, Netflix, etc., you can cast your app to your TV.

On the mobile app, look for the Google Cast icon and tap on it. Available devices will be detected and listed. Select your TV from the list and tap on it to start casting.

To cast an app to the TV screen...

1. On your smartphone or tablet, open an app that supports Google Cast.

2. Tap the Google Cast icon

3. Select the TV you would like to cast to

4. The app you selected should start playing on TV

Google Cast works on Android and iOS. Make sure that your mobile device is connected to the same network as your TV.

The menu options and naming for Google Cast function on your device can differ from Google Cast function and change with time. Refer to your device's manual for latest information on Google Cast function.

HbbTV System

HbbTV (Hybrid Broadcast TV) is a standard that seamlessly connects TV services delivered via broadband and also enables access to the Internet only services or consumers using connected TVs and set-top boxes. Services delivered through HbbTV include traditional broadcasts at TV channels, catch-up services, video on demand, electronic programme guide, interactive advertising, personalisation, voting, games, social networking and other multimedia applications. HbbTV applications are broadcast on channels where they are signalled by the broadcaster.

The HbbTV applications are generally launched with the press of a coloured button on the remote. Generally a small red button icon will appear on the screen in order to notify the user that there is an HbbTV application on that channel. Press the button indicated on the screen to launch the application.

HbbTV applications use the buttons on the remote control to interact with the user. When an HbbTV application is launched, the control of some buttons are owned by the application. For example, numeric channel selection may not work on a television application where the numbers indicate teletext pages. HbbTV requires AV streaming capability for the platform. There are numerous applications providing PVD (play-&pause), Stop, Fast Forward, and Rewind buttons on the remote control can be used to interact with the AV content.

Note: You can enable or disable this feature from the **TV Options>Advanced Options>HbbTV Settings** menu in Live TV mode.

Quick Standby Search

If earlier an automatic search is performed, your TV will search for new or missing digital channels at 05:00 am every morning while in quick standby mode. And if the **Auto Channel Update** option in the **Settings>Channel** menu is enabled, the TV will wake up within 5 minutes after it is switched into quick standby mode and search for channels. Standby LED will blink during this process. Once the standby LED stops blinking the search process is completed. Any new found channels will be added to the channel list. If the channel list is updated, you will be informed on the changes at the next power on.

Software Update

Your TV is capable of finding and updating the software automatically via Internet.

To experience the best use of your TV and benefit from the latest improvements make sure your system is always up to date.

Software update via internet

On the Home Screen enter the **Settings>Device Preferences>About** menu in order to update your Android system version. Move the focus to the **System update** option and press **OK**. You will be informed about the system status and the time at which the device was last checked for an update will be displayed. The **Check for update** option will be highlighted, press **OK** if you want to check for an available update.

Note: Do not unplug the power cord during the reboot process. If the TV fails to come on after the upgrade, unplug for two minutes then plug it back in.

Troubleshooting & Tips

TV does not switch on

• Make sure the power cord is plugged in securely to the power outlet.
• Disconnect the power cord from the power outlet. Wait for one minute then reconnect it.
• Press the **Standby/On** button on the TV.

TV does not respond to the remote control

• The TV requires some time to start up. During this time, the TV does not respond to the remote control or TV controls. This is normal behaviour.
• Check if the remote control is working by means of a mobile phone camera. Put the phone in camera mode and point the remote control to the camera lens. If you press any key on the remote control and you notice the infra red flicker through the camera, the remote control is working. The TV needs to be checked.

If you do not notice the flickering, the batteries may be exhausted. Replace them. If the remote is still not working, the remote control might be broken and needs to be checked.

This method of checking the remote control is not possible with remote controls which are wirelessly paired with the TV.

No Channels

• Make sure that all cables are properly connected and that the correct network is selected.
• Make sure that the correct channel list is selected.
• Make sure that you have entered the correct channel frequency if you have done manual tuning.

No picture / distorted picture

• Make sure that the antenna is properly connected to the TV.

• Make sure that the antenna cable is not damaged.
• Make sure that the correct device is selected as the input source.

• Make sure that the external device or source is properly connected.
• Make sure that the picture settings are set correctly.
• Loud speakers, unearthed audio devices, neon lights, high buildings and other large objects can influence reception quality. If possible try to improve the reception quality by changing the antenna direction or moving devices away from the TV.

• Change to a different picture format, if the picture does not fit the screen
• Make sure that your PC uses the supported resolution and refresh rate.

No sound / poor sound

• Make sure that the sound settings are correctly set.
• Make sure that all cables are properly connected.
• Make sure that the volume is not muted or set to zero, increase the volume to check.

• Make sure that the TV audio output is connected to the audio input on the external sound system.
• Sound may be coming from only one speaker. Check the balance settings from **Sound** menu.

Input sources - can not be selected

• Make sure that the device is connected to the TV.
• Make sure that all cables are properly connected.
• Make sure that you selected the right input source which is dedicated to the connected device.

• Sound may be coming from only one speaker. Check the balance settings from **Sound** menu.
• Make sure that the right input source is not hidden from the **Inputs** menu.
